#### **Peace Accords Fellowship**

To commemorate the 20th anniversary of the Dayton Peace Accords, the University of Dayton will award a one-year scholarship (covering the full cost of tuition, room and board) to three students from Bosnia and Herzegovina to study on our campus. The U.S. Embassy to Bosnia and Herzegovina will provide the recipients with one round-trip, economy class international air ticket from Bosnia and Herzegovina to Dayton, Ohio, as well as a settling-in allowance of \$500.

#### **Application Procedure**

To be considered for the Peace Accords Fellowship, you must be pursuing an undergraduate (bachelor's) degree from a university in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

To apply for the fellowship, complete the following steps before June 1, 2015.

- → Complete the application process for admission to the University of Dayton.
- → Enter the contest by writing a response to an assigned essay question. Then, post your essay as a note on Facebook. Make sure the privacy setting of the note is set to "Public."
